What is the Funding for?

It is to be used to assist “micro” projects, offering public and local community organisations, schools, and individuals funding for projects from £10 to a maximum of £1500, to support and stimulate involvement in healthy, active lifestyles. The fund will favour (but is not restricted to) youth projects in the Blairgowrie and surrounding areas and in particular those that offer sustainable projects within the community.

Once your application has been finalised, a signed copy should be submitted to Graham Foundation Fund, Skirmie Park, Welton Road, Blairgowrie, PH10 6NP or enquiries@grahampestcontrol.com. Applications will be looked at quarterly with the deadlines being 31 March, 30 June, 30 September and 31 December, and you will be informed of the panel’s decisions within 2 weeks of the above deadlines.

It should be noted that the Graham Foundation Fund is limited to a finite amount of funding and that grants will be awarded on order of merit until the budget limit is reached.

It should also be noted that in accepting the grant award you will be expected, upon completion of your project to submit a completion report with evidence of how your project achieved its outcomes.
